The event today saw representatives from many schools across the borough joining together to perform and demonstrate our commitment to an inclusive education system. Thank you to parents who supported the event with offers of transportation.

Year 2 have had a busy week this week. They spent Wednesday afternoon with a visitor to the school learning more about the Chinese culture and Chinese dance. On Thursday afternoon our stage area was transformed into a beach. The staff used a range of props - paddling pools, beach towels, wind breaks, shells and beach games - to create the atmosphere of a very British beach scene (including the weather!) Many thanks to all the staff across the school who continue to put so much effort into making learning exciting and relevant.

Children from Year 1 to Year 4 had a dance workshop on Wednesday morning.
